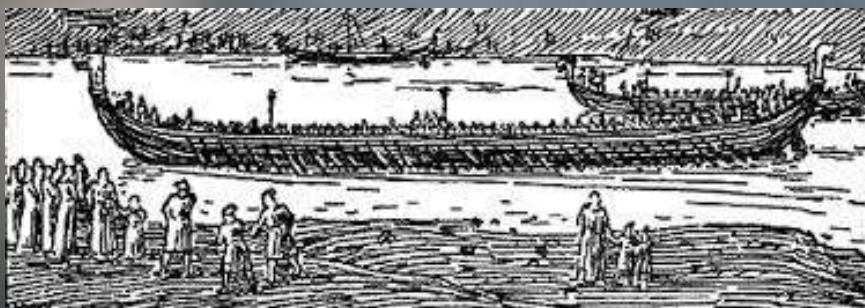

# The Norwegian Perspective

Norway :	323.802 km <sup>2</sup>
Svalbard/Jan Mayen :	61.397 km <sup>2</sup>
Maritime Zones :	2.039.000 km <sup>2</sup>
Total Area:	2,42 mill km <sup>2</sup>

# Norwegian T&E

- Scarce, but very professional T&E expertise in the Defence establishment
- A collaborative effort between the Defence establishment and the industry
- Large airspace for military manoeuvre
- Large air-to-air and air-to-ground ranges
- Live firing ranges and extensive ground training areas
- Long coastline with littoral challenges
- Underwater signature ranging facilities
  - Electromagnetic Ranges
  - Acoustic Ranges
