- Flight A Large Chapters


SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM ENHANCEMENTS

The ITEA Board of Directors has continually worked to provide ITEA Chapters with a fair and reasonable Scholarship Program to fund the Chapters scholarship and STEM grant awards. Over the past two decades the ITEA Board of Directors enhanced the ITEA Scholarship Program by:

- 1998 Increasing the maximum potential scholarship and STEM grant funds that could be earned by the hosting Chapter(s) from \$5,000 to \$10,000.
- 2001 Increasing the maximum potential scholarship and STEM grant funds that could be earned by the hosting Chapter(s) from \$10,000 for a single Chapter host, and \$18,000 for multiple Chapter hosts.
- 2006 Adding a Bonus Incentive of additional scholarship and STEM grant funds that could be earned by the hosting Chapter(s) based on significant overachievement of the event's budgeted net income
- 2011 Simplifying the formula for calculating the scholarship and STEM grant funds earned by the hosting Chapter(s) to 25% of net proceeds (35% for multiple Chapter hosts)
